CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – Do not change or cross out

Entries must be presented in a clean, complete and safe working condition. All entrants **MUST** be insured against third party risks which includes rally use, fully licensed and tested in accordance with the regulations applicable to that type of vehicle for road use. The vehicle must be covered by a motor insurance policy, having rally cover and unlimited liability (as required under the Road Traffic Acts for all motor vehicles). If you are insured under the HCVS Vehicle Insurance Scheme, rally cover is automatically included. The Society reserves the right to ask for proof of these items. Entries **WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO RUN ON TRADE PLATES.**

1. Steam wagons and engines will only be admitted if the owners can show proof of boiler insurance and annual inspection to the Run Organisers
Dates of Insurance inspection must be seen to cover the show dates (PLEASE SEND COPIES WITH ENTRY FORM)
2. It is the owners' responsibility to ensure that all drivers are fully qualified in law to handle the class of vehicle exhibited.
3. No exhibit shall be left running unattended. All unattended vehicles shall be left securely braked and/or chocked.
4. A speed limit of up to 5 mph shall apply to all vehicles including modern tender vehicles, in all rally areas off the highway.
5. Entrants and crew must pay full regard to marshals' instructions and conduct themselves in a manner which will not inconvenience other road users or entries in the rally field, or other persons at any time, or bring the Society into disrepute.
6. No vehicle will be permitted to leave the area during the presentation of trophies unless by prior arrangement.
7. Substitute entrants will only be permitted by prior arrangement with the Run Organisers.
8. No fire escape, turntable ladders, hydraulic hoists or things of a similar nature are to be extended.
9. All exhibitors must comply with the safety code in operation for the event. In any dispute the decision of the Safety Officer shall be final.
10. The owner of the vehicle will be held responsible for any weight or ground damage caused by their vehicle whilst participating in the event or on The Stray display
11. Anyone that does not abide by these Conditions of Entry will not be invited on the Run next year.
12. The decisions of the Run Organisers are final.

**Due to restricted space TENDERS OR TRANSPORTERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ONTO THE STRAY.
Unload any display vehicles in the lay-by past public car park entrance on Oatland Drive and reload there. No loaded vehicles on THE STRAY and all drivers must avoid tight turns to reduce damage to the grass.**

ALL ENTRY FORMS **MUST**** BE RETURNED BY 1st APRIL 2017 to be included in possible programme and *where applicable* a plaque guaranteed to the first 150 entrants. Please send the entry form, cheque and **SAE "A5"** to the Rally Entry Secretary (Please make sure it is in an A5 SAE (9ins x 6 1/4ins . A5 is half A4) and is the only one that is accepted**

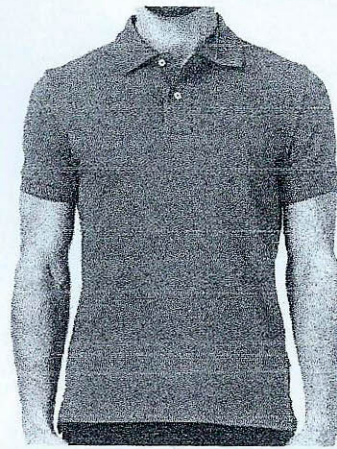
50th Trans Pennine Run Sunday 5th August 2018
